Linden L. Parr, for thirty-seven years an instructor of music in the Brooklyn schools and organist of many churches in that borough, died on Friday at his home, 204 Berkeley Place, Brooklyn, from pneumonia. Mr. Parr was born in Blairstown, N. J., seventy-eight years ago, and had lived in Brooklyn for sixty-five years. At various times he directed the music at Calvary P. E. Church, the Old Reformed Episcopal Church of the Atonement, the New England Congregational Church, and the Ross Street Presbyterian Church. He retired from the school system ten years ago. Mr. Parr was a member of De Witt Clinton Commandery, Knights Templar.
